Class times The morning class meets 8:10-10:40am and the afternoon meets 12:30-3:00pm

Transportation Morning - Please wait in the front of the building at 8:10 am when dropping your child off. We enter/exit from the main doors. Bussing home is provided at 10:40am. We walk students to the bus. Afternoon - The bus will pick up your child and bring them to school. Your child will be able to ride one of the big buses home. We will reserve the right to ask parents to transport if there are behavior concerns on the bus. Car riders will be taken to the main door for pick up. All children being picked up will need to be signed out with a staff member.

Backpack- Children need to bring their backpack and folder on a daily basis. I ask that any notes or correspondence from you be placed in your child's folder. Riverview provides the folder with a school calendar.
